Self-sacrifice Changes Everything!

This week marks the beginning of the Lenten season—the 40 days preceding Easter. Lent is intended to be a season set aside for repentance, praise and worship of the Lord. Many Christians purpose to read their Bibles and pray more often. Some choose to fast during the 40 days as a remembrance of how Jesus fasted in the desert and overcame the enemy's temptations. Ultimately, a deeper intimacy with God should be the goal of any special Lenten practices.

The self-denial that some Christ-followers engage in during Lent is a beautiful picture of death to self—something the Scriptures indicate as essential to a believer's walk. The yearly remembrance of Jesus' death and resurrection affords the opportunity to remember that we, too, "were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life (Romans 6:4)."

Practice makes permanent. My prayer for you is that during these days, you will cooperate with the Holy Spirit as He shows you attitudes and actions in your life that need to be put to death in order that your newness in Him be made

complete. As you exercise new spiritual habits of self-denial and self-sacrificing love for these 40 days, may there be increasingly more evidence of your eternal transformation into Christlikeness than you ever imagined possible!

ACMin is making a difference in our community serving as Jesus' hands and feet! See how your prayers and support are impacting the Athens area and beyond!



In January we held our 9th annual **New Year - New Heart prayer conference** with participants joining in-person and virtually from **18+ different churches**! This year's theme was "**New in Christ**" based on 2 Corinthians 5:17. Participants explored how God has made us new creations in Christ, how our new identity in Christ should affect our daily walk with Him, and how we can actually walk out our identity practically in our daily life, work, and ministry. Overwhelmingly, participants indicated that the conference was "extremely impactful."



The ACMin Prayer Ministry team has the amazing privilege of partnering weekly with the Sparrow's Nest **Breaking the Cycle** program. Breaking the Cycle is intended to help participants address their thinking, behavior, and/or substance use

disorders in order to break the cycle of generational poverty. The program prepares participants for employment at the end of the program. Our Prayer Ministers support program participants with personalized conversation, counseling, and prayer ministry. We're so grateful to partner with our community in this way.
