Finding Our Worth in Christ

Did anyone ever make fun of you—have a laugh at your expense, making you feel small? Maybe you never made the team, got picked for the lead role, or received the big promotion. Life has a way of telling us time and time again that we don't quite measure up.

Or consider a different scenario. Maybe you have been invited to a gathering of individuals who live above your personal, social or economic status. Do you feel sheepishly "less than," as if you don't belong?

Furthermore, there are things from our past that remind us to feel ashamed. We know ourselves all too well—the things we've done wrong, the lies we've told, or the blatant misdemeanors we were quick to commit. Add to that the shame we feel from having been rejected, used, traumatized or injured. Out of painful past experiences, we determine that we must be unworthy of God's love and protection. We believe so many lies—straight from the father of lies—the devil, because his goal is to extinguish the light of Christ in us.

Considering the ways we compare ourselves to others, our past wrongdoings, or the negative ways we see life as a result of how someone else sinned against us, it's difficult to really grasp that anyone can be Christlike. He was

sinless. We are not. So, we automatically disqualify ourselves and others from the category of "Christlikeness" because the image in the mirror doesn't resemble Jesus at all.

To set the record straight, if we are in Christ, we are "new creations (2 Corinthians 5:17)." The old is gone and the Lord has forever forgotten our past sins. In Him, we are already holy, righteous and blameless.

If there is any part of ourselves that we dislike, we're essentially saying that we were not fearfully and wonderfully made by God (Psalm 139:14), and that His power to redeem all our shortcomings was imperfect or incomplete (1 John 1:7; Revelation 21:5). Because Christ is living His life through us, when we deem ourselves unworthy in comparison to others, we are deciding that *He* is unworthy—that His fullness in us doesn't qualify us to wear His glory (Romans 8:30). By our own disqualification, we limit the Holy Spirit's flow through us and into a world that desperately needs a loving touch from the Kingdom.

Jesus is forever worthy (Psalm 18:3; Psalm 96:4; Revelation 5:12). His Word says that we are "as He is" in this world (1 John 4:17). It's time to agree with God about who we in Christ—worthy, powerful, holy and righteous—so that we can consistently act like who He created us to be.

Let's pray 1 Thessalonians 1:11-12 over one another until our faith comes into agreement with our identity in Christ! "We constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith. We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ."


