In 2017, CoA rezoned and purchased a stunning 114-acre parcel in Oconee County as the site of its permanent campus. We are ready to move some dirt and build a place for CoA to grow and to thrive! CoA is expanding its capacity to build a Christ-centered workforce through degree and non-degree programs and to serve our local community.

Our Campus Goal

Phase I construction includes the development of the campus infrastructure plus the House of Hope so that CoA can move to its permanent site. The House of Hope will provide classroom and faculty office spaces as well as begin to fulfill a practical need for student housing. From this base of operations, the College will be positioned to add residential student cabins, additional classrooms, and better professional space for the growing number of staff and academic faculty.
